- 6 JUL: U.S. Marshall Dana ANDRHWS is peacfully riding along one day minding his own business when some guys plug him. He finds out that they went that-away and he catches one of them to hang. The other bad guys don't want him to hang their friend so they stir up the indians, the town and everybody and Dana gets Lon Chaney (not a monster in this one) to help him cut After the showdown Dana and Jane Russell shackup in the JOHNNY RENO story.
- 7 JUL: THOSE MAGNIFICANT MEN IN THEIR FLYING MACHINES go up tedeupup and then come downdededowndown and bust their buttedebuttbutts. About the only guy you would recognize who stars in this airial belly buster is Terry Thomas who cheats. The rest of them fly and fly and crash and smash. It's funny if the projector lasts.
