A computer at Selectronics Systems Dating Bureau went awry today after a technician accidentally dropped a stack of men's card into the women's slot on the computer.

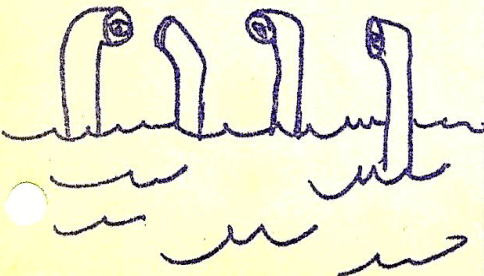

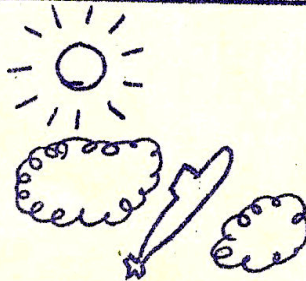

But you will have to admit we always get the last laugh

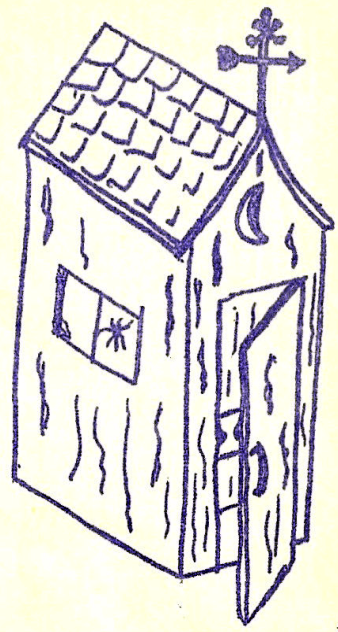
