- TUE 16 JUL: Why they called this one THE BIG KNIFE I don't know. It could have been called the big spoon or fork but anyway Jack Palance and Wendell Carey romp through hollywood bedrooms and Palance's wife Ida Lupino sues him for a divorce....
- WED 17 JUL: From out of the old west stumbles Jubal Troop (Glen Ford) and he is found half frozen on the side of a road by Shep Horgan (Erny Borgnine) who hires him to ride heard but when Jubal starts to ride heard on Shep's wife the stuff hits the fan and Jubal has to go hide with a nice gal who is the daughter of a leader of a religious sect. Rod Steiger plays Pinky who is a bad guy.

- SAT 20 JUL: Bubble Bubble Bubble.... It old Seahunt Lloyd Bridges, Brian Kelly, Gary Merrill (The Lieutenant), David (TMFU) McCallum, Keenan Wynn, Marshall (Daktari) Thompson and Shirley Eaton as the piece as they go dashing about under the ocean through earthquakes, underwater volcanos, monsters, etc. They travel in a SARGO like submarine called the Hydronaut which can go to deapths of 26,000 feet and their dangerous, humorous, romatic, thrilling, chilling escapades beneath the sea should keep even the non-quals on the edge of their seats.
- SUN 21 JUL: If you can imagine Richard Burton without Liz playing a spy you already know what THE SPY WHO CAME IN FROM THE COLD is like. The story takes place in East, West, North and South Germany in dark alleys, and the ruins of WWII bombed out buildings. Claire Bloom is the good looking spy and she and Dick have a mysterious rapport as they spy around old Germany in this super realistic clock and daggeror.
