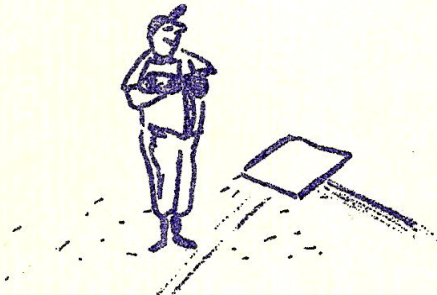

And no one will ever dare to call me a slob

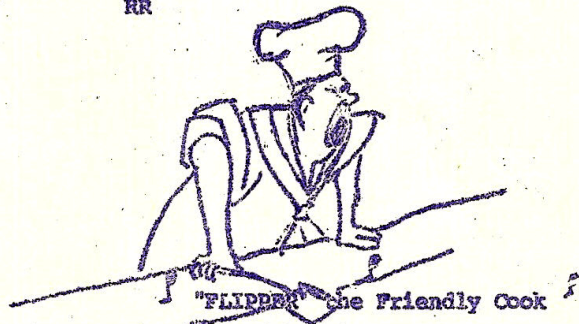

- MON 5 AUG: If you have ever wondered what happened after the gunfight at the OK Corral, this movie will be your cup of tea. It stars James Garner (Wyhet Burp), Jason Robards (Drunk Holiday) and Super Bad Guy Robert Ryan in a realistic history of the town of Tombstone after the famous gunfight although it should have been titled the year of the gun instead THE HOUR OF THE GUN.
- TUE 6 AUG: KELLY AND ME is the story about a good old song and dance man in the good old vaudeville days who has exhausted his stage popularity and stars Van Johnson, a good old song and dance man from the old vaudeville days who has exhausted his stage popularity. In the movie he hires a dog to help bring him out of his slump and Piper Laurie (what ever happened to her) plays the skirt.
- WED 7 AUG: Pretty boy Tony Curtis, playing a slick soldier stationed way the hell out at some remote Army Base, dupes the troops into sending him to Paris for a one man orgy which would be more less THE PERFECT FURLOUGH. When he gets to Paris Janet Leigh, a healthy lungful of fresh Lieutenant gets in his way and he can't find the time to get around to the real live movie star and somehow Tony ends up fraternizing with officer Leigh.
- THU 8 AUG: If you think GOLDSNAKE is some sort of pornographic takeoff on GOLDFINGER you are almost right; except that it isn't pornographic - it's just a takeoff. American Secret Agent (what would we do without them?) is sent to Singapore to rescue a brilliant scientist and his weekly secret formula and gets involved with Annabella Incontera (who sounds like a secret formula herself). There is powerful organizations, bloody battles, sacred temples, and a flock of broads.
- FRI 9 AUG: Max Von Sydow is an American (?) crop duster who piles up his plane near a small wetback village. Passing through the small town is another American (Efrem Zimbalist Jr.) ? and he has with him the piece (not sure if she is an American or not) Yvette Minieaux (pronounced Mini-moo- like a small cow). THE REWARD is the \$50,000 clams that is the price on Mr. FBI's head back in the states and soon Max Von and Gilbert (a honest to goodness wetback) start plotting on how to get the bread on Effy's head.
